This is an exciting time of **REVIVAL** at Christiania. We are confident that God is at work in our congregation.

Following several months of reviewing the needs of our church building and gathering input from our members, the Refresh Team has brought forward a plan which includes both an updating of the sanctuary and the maintenance needs of an aging building. This comprehensive plan will help to avoid coming to the congregation with multiple smaller campaigns.

On **April 10** the congregation voted to begin the Revive Campaign. During the next several weeks we are asking each of our members to prayerfully consider your gifts to this project. **This vote signals the start of the campaign to determine the financial commitment of our members.
