Greeting Christiania friends!

I am writing to you as Bo and I travel through Dar es Salaam on our way to Iringa and Ihemi. It is



such an ongoing honor to represent Christiania during our visits and work in Tanzania. This year I will be formally establishing a new program designed to empower girls in Secondary Schools by providing sexual reproduction education and reusable menstrual products. This is designed to help prevent them from missing classes on a monthly basis, and prevent disease and pregnancy. I am very excited about this new program!

Speaking of Secondary Schools, it is that time of year when student sponsorships are needing financial commitments from Christiania and our members. As a reminder, most of the girls and boys served by your gifts live in homes with no parents or just a single parent. We leave financial need evaluation to a committee of elders at Ihemi and they allocate funds based upon known family ability and economic situations. Bo and I have been involved in many mission initiatives over the past 20+ years in Iringa but the one important constant has been student sponsorship.

The average student sponsorship amounts to \$500 per year. I ask you to consider if supporting this need might fit your family plans. Sponsoring multiple students or a partial student, all make a difference in these young adults' lives. It also makes a difference for other family members in many ways. To sponsor, please just write a check to Christiania and note "Ihemi Student" in the memo line



2022 MISSIONS CHRISTMAS PROJECT

Every year, the Christiania Missions team brings forward a project at Christmas as a way for the congregation to share Christ's love in the community. This year we are partnering with Better Futures Minnesota to provide first apartment move in kits for men working to stabilize their lives.

Established in 2007, The Network for Better Futures DBA Better Futures Minnesota is a non-profit social enterprise dedicated to reintegrating high-risk adults, primarily African-American men, into society by providing a platform to help them succeed. "At Better Futures, we believe the Four Fundamentals are necessary components for building a healthy life: stable, safe housing, workforce training and good jobs; health and wellness engagement, and life skills/family coaching and mentorship. Our integrated-care model gives men access to these core needs on Day 1."

As men work through the program, they can earn their own apartment at Better Futures. When they move up, they are in need of all of those daily things we take for granted. We will be collecting household items from the list below to provide to Better Futures for their efficiency move in kits. Look for a large donation bin in the back of the sanctuary through the Christmas season.
